5. No se explican mejor por otro trastorno mental.

Intervención y tratamiento

El tratamiento suele incluir terapia cognitivo-conductual, que ayuda al paciente a identificar y modificar patrones de pensamiento disfuncionales, y en algunos casos, medicación

ansiolítica o antidepresiva. La identificación precisa mediante los criterios del DSM-5 permite diseñar un plan terapéutico dirigido a reducir la ansiedad y mejorar la calidad de vida.

Caso 2: Trastorno depresivo mayor

9. Pensamientos recurrentes de muerte o suicidio.
2. Los síntomas causan malestar clínicamente significativo o deterioro en áreas sociales, laborales o de otras áreas importantes.
3. No se explican por efectos fisiológicos de sustancia o condición médica.

Intervención y tratamiento

El tratamiento suele combinar terapia cognitivo-conductual, terapia interpersonal y medicación antidepresiva. La identificación precisa mediante los criterios del DSM-5 ayuda a diferenciarlo de otros trastornos del estado de ánimo y a establecer un plan de tratamiento efectivo.

Caso 3: Trastorno por déficit de atención e hiperactividad (TDAH) en adultos
